



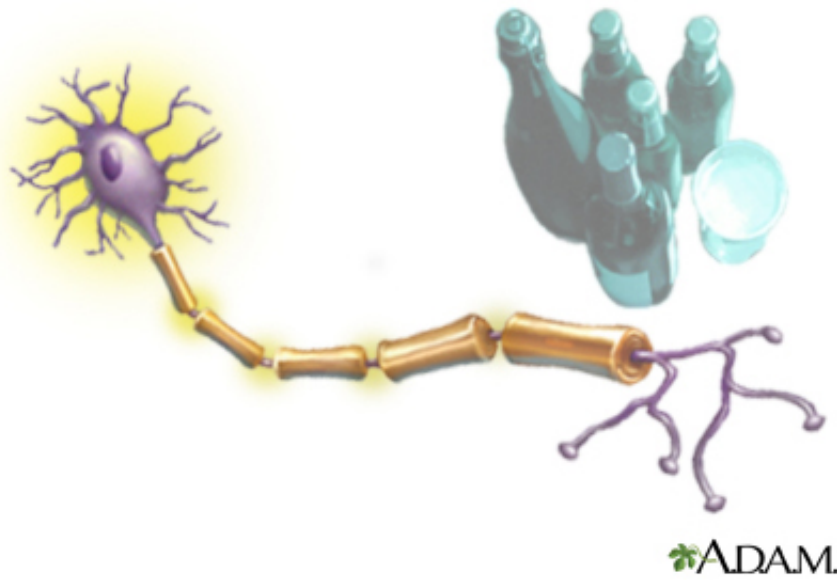
Does Alcohol Affect My Nerves?
